WASHINGTON, D.C. 2012-13 FALL/WINTER PROGRAM USA (Urban Supported Agriculture)

Our share program runs for 24 weeks and begins on Tues. 10/16 on Capitol Hill and Wed. 10/17 for with 12 bi-weekly shares. Weekly shares also available if we get 25 people minimum per location. Existing members get \$25 for new member referrals!

OPTION DESCRIPTIONS

MEAT - Grass-fed, pastured meats (may include chicken, beef, pork, bison, lamb, goat, oysters/clams and trout). All meat is humanely raised on small farms without the use of hormones or antibiotics. Meats rotate each time. A la carte offered.

DAIRY - A ½ gallon of whole milk, ½ lb of cheese (different type each week, goat chevre also available) 1 quart of plain yogurt, ½ lb cultured salted or unsalted butter, 1 dozen free-range, pastured eggs.

VEG/FRUIT - Vegetables + fruit items include a variety mix of seasonal produce from farms using organic or natural farming methods (low spray, integrative pest control etc). Winter shares may include some pantry items (jam, honey, apple butter, flour, cornmeal etc).

EGGS - 1 dozen free-range, pastured eggs (Please note eggs are also included in dairy share)

BREAD - A loaf of freshly baked bread or rolls (gluten free option available).

SOY - Twin Oaks tofu (plain and seasoned varieties), tempeh, mushroom pate and vegan sausage.

A la carte items are also available.

PRICING + OPTIONS

Choose which items you want from 1-10, or complete #12, add milk jar deposit #11 if getting milk, then add the Membership fee, #13. Then total for #14. You may join at any time during the season with a pro-rated plan based on the number of weeks left in the season. *NOTE Price shown is total for 12 bi-weekly pickups of food and includes tax. ½ shares available upon request.
