OPTION DESCRIPTIONS

MEAT - Grass-fed, pastured meats (chicken, beef, pork, bison, lamb, goat, oysters/clams and trout). All Meat is humanely raised without the use of hormones or antibiotics. Meats rotate each time. A la carte offerings include holiday meats.

DAIRY - A ½ gallon of whole milk, ½ lb of cheese (different type each week, goat chevre also available.) One quart of plain yogurt; ½ lb cultured salted or unsalted butter, 1 dozen free-range, pastured eggs.

VEG/FRUIT - Vegetables + fruit items include a variety mix of seasonal produce from farms using organic or natural farming methods (low spray, integrative pest control etc). Winter shares may include some pantry items (jam, honey, apple butter, flour, cornmeal etc).

EGGS - 1 dozen free-range, pastured eggs (Please note eggs are also included in dairy share)

BREAD - A loaf of freshly baked bread (gluten free option available).

SOY - Twin Oaks tofu (plain and seasoned varieties), tempeh, mushroom pate and vegan sausage.

A la carte items are also available.
